Moving On -Transition day for year 6

A day for year 6 students to learn about pilgrimage and its important place in Christianity and to reflect on its meaning in their life as they make the transition from Primary to Secondary Education. A chance to journey with St David from his birth at St. Non's Chapel (near the coast path) through the city and on to the place of remembrance and prayer at the Shrine in the cathedral. A day to talk, walk and reflect upon life's hopes and dreams, excitements and fears and life choices. Students will respond reflectively and creatively to the journey using items brought with them and things found on the way.



10.30-12 Introduction near the coach park. The walk starts through the lanes to St Non's and then follows an old pilgrimage route through to the city arriving at Tŷ'r Pererin. Using artefacts, the students will engage with the life story of St. David and respond to this using art materials and items brought with them.

12-12.30 Lunch

12.30 – 2 Using the amazing Pentice space at Tŷ'r Pererin students will have opportunity to write prayers or hopes for the future before experiencing a time of silence on their journey to the cathedral

shrine. The students will be sent on their way with a framed weaving made during the day as a memento of their pilgrimage.



Poetry and Pilgrimage Quiet Day – reflections provided through the poetry of RS Thomas and other Welsh poets and through prayer, space available for group and private prayer and worship, tea and coffee provided, please bring your own lunch.

10am – 2pm



Pilgrimage focus days for parishes and PCCs

Is your parish or PCC on a journey? Come here to have a day of exploration of that journey, where you are going and leave with a vision for the future. Space, AV equipment, tea and coffee provided.

We are also happy to work with you to create a pilgrimage package for a PCC or parish away day or retreat.





Drop in Days- for your Parish or community group

10am to 4pm, with prayer at 12 noon.

An opportunity to pause for prayer and personal reflection - come for all or part of the day. We are happy to lead part or all of your day using the local pilgrimage routes, images or themes. Bring your own lunch, coffee and tea provided.




Journeying through prayer – suitable for parish groups, Mothers Union etc.

A spiritual pilgrimage of prayer, a walk around Ty'r Pererin, through St Davids and into the Cathedral. Spiritual reflections and prayers provided and space to respond in Ty'r Pererin through contemplation and quiet. Opportunities can be provided to respond creatively if discussed prior to the visit.





In the steps of St David



A pilgrimage day suitable for church youth groups, Sunday School or children's clubs. An opportunity to learn about pilgrimage, visit the cathedral and journey around in the steps of St David. A chance to respond creatively in Ty'r Pererin through games, music, art and drama.
