One of the 12th Century Bishops croziers usually on display in the Treasury has been loaned to the British Museum for the exhibition: Thomas Becket, Murder and the Making of a Saint. The catalogue book of the exhibition is now on sale in the Cathedral shop. In the Treasury is a display including copies of the medieval Chronicle of the Welsh Princes / Brut y Tywysogion which reports the visit on pilgrimage to St Davids in 1171 by King Henry II after the murder of Thomas Becket. In September 2021 we will be marking the 850th anniversary of this visit.
