Donations and collections – Due to the pandemic, donations can be made via the contactless pay point or via the gift aid envelopes in your pew. Please be guided by the stewards if you are unsure about where to put your envelope as you leave.

Food Bank – Food bank donations and contributions are especially important in the current environment, and the Cathedral continues to support the local food bank by having a donation point near the font at the rear of the nave. Any non-perishable food donations are always welcome and special requests will be noted at the donation point.

Cathedral Library and Treasury - The Cathedral Library is open on Monday and Friday afternoons 2pm to 4pm. Bookings can be made on EventBrite. The public display in the Treasury, off the north transept, includes 12th century croziers and artefacts, with a display of the medieval Brut y Tywysogion / Chronicles of the Princes.

There are still a few copies remaining in the Cathedral shop of the British Museum catalogue book "Thomas Becket Murder and the Making of a Saint", based on the Museum's exhibition this summer including one of St Davids Cathedral's 12th century croziers.

Changes to the weekly pattern of services – Having run through a cycle of services, we have amended the Sunday 9.30am Parish Services to reflect that. The 9.30am Parish Communion will continue in the Lady Chapel, with the amendment of there not being a concurrent Family Service on the 4th Sunday of the month, there will only be the Welsh Cymun y Plwyf. In November and December there will be joint services on Remembrance Sunday, Advent Sunday and the Sunday before Christmas.

Please note - British Summer time ended on the 31st October, and Sunday Evensong, as well as all Evening Prayer services in the week (NOT weekday Choral Evensongs) move to the winter time of 4pm. Due to the large congregations on Sundays at the moment, we will also not be moving to the Quire for Sunday services.
